### What is a commitment?



An obligation to an external stakeholder to provide a feature or perform an action related to a project.

### Why are project commitments made?

- Provide assurances to stakeholders,
- To help advance a project to its next phase.

### **FDOT Outlined Procedure**

- FDOT Topic # 700-011-035-a (November 2012)
- •Applies to Central Office, District staff and Consultants involved in the project development process (PD&E, Design, ROW and Construction).

### When are project commitments made?

 During any project phase (PD&E, Design, ROW, Construction, Operations & Maintenance)

## Who is responsible for making project commitments?

The appropriate FDOT Project Manager

## How are project commitments documented?

•Within the project's environmental document and completion of the Project Commitments Record (PCR).

## How are project commitments passed along to future Project Phases?

- The PD&E PM is responsible for providing the PCR and the environmental document to the Design PM.
- At completion of the Design phase, the Design PM is responsible for incorporating the PCR into the Design plans and delivering the updated PCR to the Construction phase PM.
- The Construction phase PM is ultimately responsible for ensuring commitments in the PCR are met and documented.

## Are project commitments readdressed after the PD&E phase?

• Yes, as project Reevaluations are completed by the Environmental Management staff, status updates are provided in the Reevaluation documentation for all project commitments.
