

Overview

The Area of Interest (AOI) Editor Tool within the Environmental Screening Tool (EST) Map Viewer allows a user to define and analyze an area anywhere in Florida to learn more about people, places, and natural resources at that location.

Quick Steps



- 1. Create an AOI Navigate through the various pages to create a brand new AOI.
 - *Name, Type, Description, Keep Until:* Name your AOI, select a type, enter a description (optional), and set a date at which the AOI will expire.
 - *Features:* Draw points, lines, and/or polygons that represent your AOI. Once a feature has been completed and added to the map, it will display in a Features table within the AOI Editor Tool. Click on a row/feature in this table or click the feature on the map to display the editing options.
 - Analysis Areas: If desired, group features together. Grouped features are analyzed together as a single analysis area and can contain multiple disconnected parts.
 - Results: Access and view reports.
- 2. **Open an AOI** Open a previously created/saved AOI.
 - Set criteria: Refine the results that will be displayed.
 - Load: Load and display the AOI on the map.
 - Results: Access and view reports.
- 3. **Toggling Tools** Hide or show the overall panel by clicking the arrow tab in the middle, right of the panel. Clicking on a blue header will expand or collapse a tool.
- 4. **Help** Displays a variety of help topics such as navigation or search tips. Additionally, help videos and quick reference documents can be accessed in this section.
