# Integrating ETDM, Advance Notification, and Federal Consistency Processes



## New Integrated Process

How do ETDM, Advance Notification, and Federal Consistency fit together?

- Programming Screen notification constitutes
   Advance Notification (AN) and initiates
   Federal Consistency Review
- ETAT and Federal Consistency Reviewers use the EST to submit comments
- State Clearinghouse reviews comments and completes the consistency determination for Florida's Coastal Management Program





## Preparing the AN Package


- ETDM Coordinator Ensures that the Following Items are Complete:
  - Project Moved to Programming Phase
  - Lead Agency Identified
  - Project-specific Contact List Created
  - Federal Aid Form Attached, if Applicable





#### Step 1. Send Notifications

- ETDM Coordinator sends electronic notifications to:
  - State Clearinghouse Coordinator
  - ETAT Members
  - State Federal Consistency Reviewers
  - Other Interested Parties
- Includes project identifier, instructions, and links to AN and website
- Initiates 45-day comment period







## Step 2. Review Project

- Upon receipt of notification:
  - Review project Information provided in AN Package and on EST website
  - Coordinate activities and project commentary within agency
  - Submit comments or request extension within 45 days
    - ETAT and State Federal Consistency Reviewers submit comments on EST
    - Other interested parties submit comments via email, written correspondence, or public workshops





## Step 2. Review Project (cont.)

- ETAT specific responsibilities
  - Comment on purpose and need
  - Describe project effects to resources under agency authority
  - Recommend avoidance/ minimization
  - Suggest mitigation strategies
  - Assess degree of effect
  - Coordinate to reduce conflicts






## Step 2. Review Project (cont.)

- Federal Consistency Reviewer specific responsibilities
  - Review projects for consistency with the Florida Coastal Management Program, as pertains to agency authority
  - For inconsistency findings:
    - Cite relevant statutes
    - Identify actions to resolve the conflict
    - Immediately notify the State Clearinghouse of identified problems







## Step 2. Review Project (cont.)

- For agencies with different ETAT and Federal Consistency Review personnel
  - Ensure Federal Consistency Review and ETAT comments are not in conflict

#### **Recommendation:**

Consider assigning the commenting responsibilities to the same individual






#### Step 3. Summarize Reviews

- State Clearinghouse Coordinator submits
   Consistency Determination within 15 days
- FDOT District ETDM Coordinator summarizes ETAT comments and publishes Preliminary Programming Screen Summary Report within 60-days
- Reviewers receive email when summary report is available
