On behalf of FHWA, and in accordance with Section 6002 of SAFETEA-LU, we are requesting your agency to be a Cooperating Agency on the EIS for the above referenced project. Since this process is now covered under the ETDM agreements, we are sending this request via e-mail, and you may reply by e-mail. These e-mails will become part of the project record in the Programming Summary Report stored on the Environmental Screening Tool (EST).

The suggested role of a Cooperating Agency includes the following items, some of which you may have already completed as part of your ETDM review.

1. Provide meaningful and early input on defining the purpose and need, determining the range of alternatives to be considered, and the methodologies and level of detail required in the alternatives analysis.
2. Participate in coordination meetings and joint field reviews as appropriate.
3. Timely review and comment on the pre-draft or pre-final environmental documents to reflect the views and concerns of your agency on the adequacy of the document, alternatives considered, and the anticipated impacts and mitigation.

Please respond to me via e-mail (with a copy to George Hadley at FHWA) with an acceptance or denial of this invitation prior to **January 19, 2008**. If your agency declines, the response should state your reason for declining the invitation. Pursuant to SAFETEA-LU Sec. 6002, any Federal agency that chooses to decline the invitation to be a Cooperating Agency must specifically state in its response that it:

- Has no jurisdiction or authority with respect to the project;
- Has no expertise or information relevant to the project; and
- Does not intend to submit comments on the project.
