In addition, please review this project's consistency, to the maximum extent feasible, with the approved Comprehensive Plan of the local government to comply with Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes.

We look forward to receiving your comments on this project within 45 days. Should additional review time be required, a written request for a 15 day extension must be submitted to our office within the initial 45-day comment period.

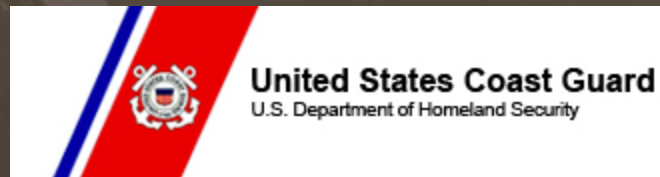
